Seedling inspections are required if you need to waive land history in order to produce a crop of certified seed in the current crop year. Land history standards vary by crop, and can be found in WSCIA's Certified Seed Growers Guide. The seedling inspection will be conducted to evaluate if the cultural practices in the field have proven successful to prevent volunteers from the previous crop in the current seed crop.

Seedling inspections are to be conducted at the 3-4 leaf stage, and no later than 6" of plant height, or plant canopy. Please submit the Application for Seedling Field Inspection, **including a map that clearly shows location of field and field boundaries**, as soon as possible after planting (within 10 days). The fee for seedling inspections is \$2.60/acre.
